Information Regarding Music Lessons

1. *Starting age:* piano, guitar, and string lessons start at age 5. Brass, woodwinds, and percussion start at age 10. Voice lessons start at age 15. There is no age limit for adults. Exceptions may be made in extraordinary circumstances.
2. All students must rent or own an instrument. Piano students must have a piano or keyboard.
3. Please arrive promptly to help us stay on schedule.
4. Parents are welcome to attend lessons as long as they do not interfere with the lesson.
5. During the first lesson, the instructor will assign books or other materials the student must purchase and bring to each lesson.
6. All lessons take place at the YMCA.
7. To register, please complete and return the information form above and complete registration through the YMCA front desk. Your lesson time will be arranged by the Director.
8. *Payment procedure:* the YMCA bills for lessons on a monthly basis for lessons to be taken that month. Payment must be arranged before the first lesson each month.
9. *Cancellation procedure:* If you have to cancel a lesson or lessons, you must call the instructor at least *24 hours in advance* of the lesson time to avoid being charged for that lesson. You will receive contact information for your instructor at your first lesson. You will never be charged for lessons cancelled by your instructor or the YMCA.
