## After-School Child Care

The YMCA believes a child care program should provide opportunities and experiences which stimulate a child's physical, social, intellectual and emotional development. In order to accomplish this, we provide gym activities, games, arts and crafts, books, healthy snacks and activities with other local agencies. The program meets the developmental needs of particular age groups as well as the individual needs of each child. The after school program is licensed by New York State and operates Monday-Friday when school is in session. All after school care begins at school release until 6:00 PM. Our Wayland/Cohocton program also offers a morning school care program which runs from 6:30 AM until school starts at 9:00 AM.
